## Sectioning Information

### Mathematics

To enroll in Math Ma, Math 1a, Math 1b, Math 21a, and Math 21b, you must section by computer during the period starting Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>, and no later than 12 pm (noon) on Thursday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Directions for sectioning by computer:

If you have an email account, log onto the Harvard computer system, and instead of typing "pine," type  
"ssh section@ulam.fas.harvard.edu"  
and follow the instructions there.

**Windows:** From a Windows computer, open the SecureCRT application [Download from FAS]. Use the "Quickconnect" menu to open a connection with protocol  
ssh2, hostname: ulam.fas.harvard.edu and  
username: section

**Macintosh OS X:** From a Macintosh with OS X, start the "Terminal" application located under Applications/Utilities. At the shell prompt, type  
"ssh section@ulam.fas.harvard.edu"  
and type return.

**Linux or Unix:** Using any Linux or Unix computer, login into your FAS account. At the shell prompt, type  
"ssh section@ulam.fas.harvard.edu" and type return.
